

Refund Policy

- For Hakomi workshops and trainings in Boulder, CO and Princeton, NJ -

For introductory workshops in Boulder or Princeton:

- \$75-\$100 non-refundable deposit to reserve a space in the workshop
- The balance of tuition is refundable

For the Comprehensive Training in Boulder, CO:

A student shall be refunded tuition within 30 days under the following terms:

- a) A full refund of all monies paid less application fee if the applicant is not accepted to the training.
- b) A full refund of tuition paid less \$500.00 deposit if the student withdraws prior to starting the program.
- c) A student terminating his/her training during the first 20% of his/her program is entitled to a refund of 80% of the contract price less \$150.00 cancellation/administrative/materials fee. A student may terminate for any reason during this period, providing they follow the procedure described in the training contract.
- d) A student terminating his/her training after the first 20%, but within the first 50% of his/her program is entitled to a refund of 50% of the contract price less \$150.00 cancellation/administrative/materials fee. During this period a student may receive a refund if terminating for reasons of emergency or serious illness, or other extenuating circumstances, as recognized and agreed by the training providers.
- e) A student terminating his/her training after the first 50%, but within the first 80% of his/her program may receive a refund, *if budget permits*, of 20% of the contract price, less \$150.00 cancellation/administrative/materials fee, if terminating for reasons of emergency or serious illness (or other extenuating circumstances as recognized and agreed by the training providers.)
- f) A student who has completed more than 80% of his/her program shall not be entitled to any refund and shall be obligated for the full price of the program.

The student must notify the Training Providers (Hakomi Trainings L.L.C.) in writing of his/her intent to withdraw from the training. Refund will be calculated from date of written notice, according to the above schedule, and a termination agreement will be signed which cancels this contract.

The Training Providers reserve the right to cancel this contract at any time prior to the start of the training, and if so will refund any tuition paid.

For the Comprehensive Training in Princeton, NJ:

For Module One:

A student shall be refunded tuition within 30 days under the following terms:

- a) A full refund of all monies paid less application fee if the applicant is not accepted to the training.
- b) A full refund of tuition paid less \$500.00 deposit if the student withdraws prior to starting the program.
- c) A student terminating his/her training during the first 12 days (3 segments) of his/her program is entitled to a refund of all tuition paid, less \$1500 for tuition, cancellation fee and materials fees. A student may terminate for any reason during this period, providing they follow the procedure described above in the training contract.
- d) A student terminating his/her training after the first 12 days, but within the first 20 days (5 segments/62%) of his/her program is entitled to a refund of 35% of the contract price less \$150.00 cancellation fee and up to \$50.00 materials fee. During this period a student may receive a refund if terminating for reasons of emergency or serious illness, or other non-financial extenuating circumstances, as recognized and agreed upon by the training providers.
- f) A student who has completed more than 65% of his/her program will not be entitled to any refund and will be obligated for the full price of the program.

The student must notify the Training Providers (Hakomi Trainings L.L.C.) in writing of his/her intent to withdraw from the training., after following the withdrawal procedure described in the contract above..

The Training Providers reserve the right to cancel this contract at any time prior to the start of the training, and if so will refund any deposit or tuition paid.

For Module Two:

- a. Participation in Module One of the Comprehensive Training has allowed the student to make an informed decision about choosing to participate in Module Two. Therefore, it is agreed that there will be no refunds for withdrawals during the second half of Module Two. Refunds for withdrawal during the first half of Module Two are entirely at the discretion of the Training Providers, and will be considered only based on very extenuating circumstances, such as serious illness.
