

Hakomi Southeast Training Team Scholarship Information

Purpose

In alignment with our principles of unity, organicity, nonviolence, mindfulness and mind-body holism, as well as our core practice of loving presence, the Hakomi Southeast training team is committed to offering scholarships to expand training affordability for:

- Individuals who are members of or serve underrepresented populations, including: people of the BIPOC community (people of the global majority), the LGBTQ+ community, people with disabilities, and people in marginalized or low-income communities.

Eligibility

Candidates must meet the following conditions to be eligible for consideration for this scholarship:

- Meet the above criteria
- Have applied and been accepted into the upcoming Hakomi Southeast training
- Would provide Hakomi therapy services to diverse or underserved populations ●

Submit a scholarship application

Other Considerations

- Enrollment space and scholarship funds are limited
- Hakomi Southeast training team reserves the right to determine candidates who are eligible to receive scholarships
- Applicants who do not meet the requirements will not be eligible for the scholarship award
- **When a scholarship is NOT granted and the candidate decides to withdraw from the training, they will have 2 weeks to withdraw** and their training deposit will be refunded. After that time, the withdrawal/refund policy for the training will be in effect. Scholarship awards are non-transferable.

Disclaimer

It is the responsibility of applicants to request a scholarship, and all requests must be made prior to the scheduled start date of the training. Scholarships are not available after the course begins.

Scholarship Application

Once your training application is submitted and accepted, please request and submit the scholarship application.

Scholarship Amount

Each scholarship will cover a maximum of 50% of the training tuition and will not include travel expenses related to in-person training. (A limited amount of scholarship funding is available. Requesting less than 50% support will allow more people to receive scholarships.)
